Report of the Inspection Team of West Bengal University of Technology, Kolkata Visiting Sabita Devi Education Trust-Brainware Group of Institutions(College Code-270) on 8th may 2014 from 12.00 noon to 2.30 p.m

The Team has made Physical Verification of the Infrastructure met with the faculty and gone through the relevant records. Following Observation have been made:

1. The College Infrastructure is by and large acceptable.
2. Adequate arrangement are there for the physically-handicapped persons.
3. Student intake is acceptable
4. There is no Permanent Librarian since the inception of the College.
5. Number of Fire Extinguishers is far too less than adequate.
6. Though a rigarous faculty appraisal system is in place, the report is not shared with the relevant faculty members leading to confusion and disappointment.
7. Faculty:Student ratio is inadequate.
8. These are very few faculty members in senior position.

The Points may be noted at the appropriate level in the University.
